

Superior Black Vinyl Retains Its Color EVEN AFTER EIGHT YEARS

Any manufacturer can make black vinyl. The real question is: how does it hold up? If manufacturers choose to cut corners in their colored vinyl extrusions, the color will start strong, but will fade and even start to take on a purple hue over time. Superior co-extrudes its black vinyl, meaning that the black color is not a laminate or paint—it's part of the vinyl itself. And the black shade is created with high-quality formulations and color protectants that prevent drastic fading.

Of course, anyone can tell you that their black color doesn't fade. Superior can show you.
